

## Associate of Science in Business

The Associate of Science in Business degree allows students to begin pursuing their personal, professional and educational goals. Spring Arbor University's program integrates faith and learning to provide a unique experience. The program is designed with a business focus for pre-professionals in the field who currently lack formal education. This degree may be used as a springboard for further education in a bachelor's degree program.

### GETTING STARTED

- 1 | Submit a completed application and \$30 application fee. (If you apply online, we waive the fee.)
- 2 | Have an official high school transcript sent to our offices.
- 3 | Complete a writing sample. Students without a passing writing sample must successfully complete ENG 103 or an equivalent course prior to starting the program.
- 4 | Provide proof of two years of post high school work experience and a photo ID.
- 5 | Complete financial aid information such as the FAFSA, student loan request forms and employer assistance forms, if applicable.

Students whose native language is not English must achieve a TOEFL exam score of 197. SAU reserves the right to require additional information from a student who shows evidence of inadequate preparation for college-level studies.
