ALPENA COMMUNITY (2007-2008) --SPRING ARBOR UNIVERSITY (2007-2008)

This is only a guide. Please refer to the Spring Arbor University catalog for transfer admission requirements, specific course information, and program requirements. Because institutions may change course descriptions, numbers, or other designators without notice, the information in this transfer guide may not reflect the most recent information available. Please consult with a Spring Arbor University admissions representative concerning questions about specific courses. A student who satisfies the MACRAO Agreement at ACC (Must be completed before starting at SAU) will be accepted as having fulfilled the general education freshman and sophomore year requirements, unless otherwise specified by a particular program (e.g. Teacher Education). For any course to transfer, it must be numbered 100-299 and the grade earned must be "C" (2.0) or higher. If a student does not fulfill MACRAO, the following courses are suggested:

1. English -- 6 hours
ENG 111 or 121 **and** 112 or 122 (ENG 112 or 122 must have a 2.5 or better for teacher education)
2. Oral Communication – 3 Hours
SPE 121 **or** 123
3. Physical Education – PEH 110
4. Fine Arts –
HUM 241 **or** 242
5. Humanities (Literature) –
ENG 203 (required for English major or minor) **or** FRN 122 or SPN 126 (the equivalent of two semesters of foreign language)
6. Natural Science -- One Laboratory science from the following:
BIO 110 or higher (excluding BIO 217)
CEM 110 -- 122 or 221 -- 224
PHY 111 – 122 or 124 -- 222

AND -- One from the following:
MTH 111 -- 117 or 121 or above
OR CIS 120
7. Philosophy –
PHL 225
8. Religion -- None
9. Social Science – One course from the following:
HIS 121, 122, 221, or 222
AND One of the following
ECN 231 or 232
PSY 225 (required for teacher education)
SOC 123, or 227
