

## GENERAL EDUCATION TRANSFER GUIDE

### DELTA COLLEGE (2006-2007) --SPRING ARBOR UNIVERSITY (2006-2007)

**This is only a guide.** Please refer to the Spring Arbor University catalog for transfer admission requirements, specific course information, and program requirements. Because institutions may change course descriptions, numbers, or other designators without notice, the information in this transfer guide may not reflect the most recent information available. Please consult with a Spring Arbor University admissions representative concerning questions about specific courses. A student who satisfies the MACRAO Agreement at Delta (Must be completed before starting at SAU) will be accepted as having fulfilled the general education freshman and sophomore year requirements, unless otherwise specified by a particular program (e.g. Teacher Education). For any course to transfer, it must be numbered 100-299 and the grade earned must be "C" (2.0) or higher. If a student does not fulfill MACRAO, the following courses are suggested:

1. English -- 6 hours  
ENG 111 **and** 112 (ENG 112 must have a 2.5 or better for teacher education)
2. Oral Communication – 3 Hours  
SPE 112 **or** 202
3. Physical Education – LW 220 **and** 101, 106, 110, 111, 157, 159, **or** 183
4. Fine Arts –  
ART 101, 105, 151, **or** 152 **and** MUS111 (Two semesters of a large musical performance group may be substituted for the music portion of fine arts.)
5. Humanities (Literature) –  
LIT 228 **or** 241 (required for English major or minor) **or** FR 112, GE 112, or SPA 112 (the equivalent of two semesters of foreign language)
6. Natural Science -- One Laboratory science from the following:  
BIO 110, 111, 130 – 203, 240, **or** 241  
CEM 101 -- 112  
GLG 111-118 **or** 130  
PHY 101 – 212  
  
**AND** -- One from the following:  
MTH 115, 116 **or** 118 or above  
**OR** CST 133
7. Philosophy –  
PHL 211
8. Religion – LIT 245 and/or 246 (One course in New Testament and one in Old Testament are required. 58 transferable hours waives one course )
9. Social Science – One course from the following:  
HIS 111 -- 222  
**AND** One of the following  
ECN 221 or 222  
PSY 211 (required for teacher education)  
SOC 211, 212, or 221
