

Dual Enrollment Program at Spring Arbor University

To enroll in the High School Dual Enrollment program, the student must:

1. Be a high school junior or senior
2. Have a GPA of at least 3.2 or an ACT score of 21
3. Designate a school official or parent as a mentor
4. Must meet with a Spring Arbor University admissions representative
5. Only take a course if space is available after Spring Arbor University students have registered.
6. The applicant must submit:
 - i. The enrollment form to be accepted into the program and to enroll for classes (acceptance into the high school dual enrollment program does not guarantee acceptance to SAU post-graduation.)
 - ii. The \$30 application fee
 - iii. A high school transcript (we will accept a faxed copy in order to get you started as we wait for your official copy.) If it is a student's **first** dual enrollment course, they must submit the enrollment application along with their official high school transcript. If they have taken a dual enrollment course before (and received at least a C or better) they just fill out the enrollment application.
 - iv. ACT score

Once you are enrolled:

7. Student must earn a grade of "C" or better in order to remain in the dual enrollment program
8. Students may take a maximum of 6 credits under the dual enrollment program at \$90 per credit hour (anything above six credits will be charged at the regular 2009-2010 enrolled student rate of \$485 per credit hour).
9. If enrolled on-campus, the student must also pay other required fees for Spring Arbor University
10. Tuition must be paid prior to the start of the course
