Spring Arbor University will accept a maximum of 68 semester hours from a community college. Following is a list of Mid-Michigan Community College transfer courses, which may be applied to meet the intent of SAU courses. Mid-Michigan Community College courses not listed here may also transfer, as general elective credit (or to meet course requirements in an available major or minor), if they are numbered 100-299 and the grade earned is a “C” (2.0) or higher. 100-level courses will not be considered upper division credit at SAU. 200-level courses that meet the intent of Upper Level (300-399) courses at SAU may count as Upper Level credit, on a course-by-course basis. Transferable, technical hours are limited to 20.
