Dr. Ying-Li Pan is the Professor of Applied Violin at Spring Arbor University. She started her musical studies on piano at the age of six and on violin at age seven. She earned her Master of Music from University of South Carolina where she studied with Donald Portnoy and completed her Doctor of Music Performance from Michigan State University where she studied with Dimitri Berlinsky and Yvonne Lam.

She has appeared as second principal and assistant concertmaster violin at Brevard Music Festival in 2015 and was accepted to the Aspen Music Festival in 2020. Her recognitions and awards include: the MTNA – Music Teachers National Association – the state competition of South Carolina first prize in 2011 and 2012, the University of South Carolina concerto-aria competition in 2012 and First Prize winner of American Protégé international strings competition in 2022.
