Ms. Pollard also frequently performs in the Opera Grand Rapids chorus and the Fountain Street Church Oratorio Choir. In addition, she often works as a freelance artist for many churches and non-profit organizations, such as St. Timothy's Episcopal Church, Zion Lutheran Church, and The American Gold Star Mothers of Ohio, to name a few. Ms. Pollard currently studies voice with soprano, Emily Douglass.
